- U.S. Veteran's Administration Application for Standard Government Headstone or Marker (VA Form 40-1330)
 - > Provided free of charge to mark the veteran's grave.
- □ Application for Burial Benefits (VA Form 21-520)
 - An application for funeral and burial allowance. (Very few qualify for this reimbursement.)
- One Sum Payment Claim (VA Form 29-4125)
 - > An application for veteran's life Insurance.
- Application for Presidential Memorial Certificate(s)
 - Letter of recognition signed by the President of the United States.
- □ State of Illinois Veteran's Grave Registration Form (DVA Form 3WVGR/IL 497-004)
