



# Information about Veteran's Benefits

Spengel-Boulanger Funeral Home has completed the following applications and forms on your behalf to claim benefits for your deceased veteran...

- ❑ **U.S. Veteran's Administration Military Records Request**  
(Standard Form 180-106)
  - A form will be completed if the veteran's family is unable to locate the veteran's records.
- ❑ **Burials in National Cemeteries**
  - The Funeral Home will schedule burials in National Veteran's Cemeteries.
- ❑ **Military Honors**
  - The Funeral Home will arrange Full Military Honors that include a rifle squad with a gun salute, bugler, and color guard.
- ❑ **Application for United States Flag for Burial** (VA Form 2008)
  - Flag provided by government to drape the casket at the veteran's funeral.
- ❑ **U.S. Veteran's Administration Application for Standard Government Headstone or Marker** (VA Form 40-1330)
  - Provided free of charge to mark the veteran's grave.
- ❑ **Application for Burial Benefits** (VA Form 21-520)
  - An application for funeral and burial allowance. (Very few qualify for this reimbursement.)
- ❑ **One Sum Payment Claim** (VA Form 29-4125)
  - An application for veteran's life insurance.
- ❑ **Application for Presidential Memorial Certificate(s)**
  - Letter of recognition signed by the President of the United States.
- ❑ **State of Illinois Veteran's Grave Registration Form**  
(DVA Form 3WVGR/IL 497-004)
