Alan Milton Pearce, 70 years and 9.5 months old, of Mesa, AZ, passed away suddenly of pancreatic cancer, April 1, 2019, at his home in Mesa, AZ.

Alan was born on June 15, 1948 in Highland, IL, to Milton W. and Georgene M. Pearce (nee Kaufman).

Alan grew up in Apache Junction, AZ. He graduated from Apache Junction High School, Class of 1968. Going on to join the Air Force, he was honorably discharged in December of 1974.
