Adolph H. Sievers, age 88, of Hamel, IL., died Monday, January 14, 2008, at Anderson Hospital in Maryville, IL.

He was born November 10, 1919, in Livingston, IL., the son of William and Clara (nee Hering) Sievers.

On February 24, 1946, he married Alice M. Sievers , who survives.

He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Hamel, IL; church Men's Club; Worden American Legion Post #564; Retired Hamel Volunteer Fire Dept.; member and chairman of Southern Illinois District Scholarship Committee of LCMS for 20 years; & Lutheran Laymens League.
