Agnes Rose Kampwerth, age 89 of Highland, IL, died Wednesday, September 24, 2014, at Faith Care Center in Highland, IL.

She was born July 19, 1925, in St. Rose, IL, the daughter of William Anton and Wilhelmina (nee Tebbe) Benhoff.

On May 08, 1946, she married Alfred B. Kampwerth who passed away on January 15, 2008.
