Alan C. "Snorts" May, age 73 of Edwardsville, IL, died Tuesday, March 08, 2022, at Saint Louis University Hospital in Saint Louis, MO.

He was born on Tuesday, June 15, 1948, in Wood River, IL, the son of Lyman and Mildred (nee Reid) May.

Alan was a member of Immanuel United Methodist Church, Edwardsville, IL; Royal Order of the Moose-Lodge 1561-Edwardsville and former member of the Marine Volunteer Fire Department.

Alan grew up on the family farm west of Marine, IL and graduated from Triad High School in 1966. Alan worked for Monsanto first as a pipefitter and later in his career as Director of Safety for Solutia. After 37 years of service, Alan retired to manage the family farm.
