



## Alvin P. Steiner

May 31, 1932 - September 7, 2016

Alvin P. Steiner, age 84 of Pocahontas, IL, died Wednesday, September 7, 2016, at Saint Louis University Hospital in Saint Louis, MO.

He was born on Tuesday, May 31, 1932, in Pocahontas, IL, the son of Leo A. and Aline A. (nee Niggli) Steiner.

On Tuesday, June 05, 1956, he married Jo-Ann M. (nee Suess) Steiner at Grantfork United Church of Christ, who survives.

He was a member of Grantfork United Church of Christ. in 1978. He then raised grain on the farm until early 2000's. He was a school bus driver for 18 years. He enjoyed playing cards (Jass every Tuesday for years). He enjoyed his family, traveling with his family and siblings. He was an avid Baltimore Orioles fan from when they were the St. Louis Browns. He never missed a school event for sons and grandchildren. He enjoyed and had a large collection of Eagles.
