Anthony M. "Tony" Frey, age 77 of Highland, IL, died Saturday, November 15, 2014, at Saint Luke's Hospital-West in Chesterfield, MO.

On Saturday, May 16, 1964, he married Velta M. Frey (nee Kantner) who passed away on Friday, November 28, 1997.

St. Louis Cardinals and watching WWE on TV. He loved driving Scott Frey's big green Steiger tractor. He loved his grandchildren and was admired and loved by everyone.
