



Arlyne L. Loudon

August 9, 1912 - June 12, 2007

Arlyne L. (nee Harriss) Loudon, age 94, of Highland, IL., died Tuesday, June 12, 2007, at Faith Care Center-Faith Countryside Homes, Highland, IL.

She was born August 9, 1912, in Herrin, IL., the daughter of Orville and Ima (nee Norman) Harriss.

On June 18, 1933, she married Francis M. \"Hank\" Loudon, who passed away June 13, 1995.

At age 9 months her family moved to Christopher, IL where she graduated from Christopher High School. She attended Southern Illinois University at Carbondale for three years. Following her marriage, she and her husband lived in St. Louis, MO/Springfield, IL and moved to Highland, IL in 1940. Mrs. Loudon has been a resident of Highland ever since. (Her husband owned and operated Highland Builder's Supply Company in Highland for over 28 years.) Mrs. Loudon substituted as a teacher at Highland Community Schools for over 25 years. She was an avid golfer and Bridge player. She enjoyed reading and crafts. She had been active in the American Cancer Society for years.

In July of 2000 she moved to the Highland Home; and Spring of 2007 she moved to the Faith Care Center.

She was a member of First Congregational Church, Highland, IL; Dorcas Fellowship of her church; Order of the Eastern Star, Highland Chapter 524; Past Matron of the OES-Chapter 524 (1950).
