Arthur J. Flaiz, age 90 of Highland, IL, died Wednesday, January 07, 2015, at Saint Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

He was born on Monday, December 29, 1924, in Quincy, IL, the son of Carl F. and Agnes (nee Bueter) Flaiz.

On Monday, April 22, 1946, he married Dorothy Mae Flaiz (nee Padavic) who survives in Highland.

He was a member of Saint Paul Catholic Church. He was also a member of Kinghts of Columbus Council #1580; V.F.W. Post 5694 of Highland; American Legion/Lee Iten Post #439; and St. Joseph Hospital Auxiliary-Highland.
