Bernell C. Deuser, age 89 of Sorento, IL, died Friday, September 24, 2021, at Alhambra Care Center in Alhambra, IL.

He was born on Thursday, June 09, 1932, in Highland, IL, the son of Clarence and Milda (nee Weiss) Deuser.

On Monday, April 14, 1952, he married Joan L. Deuser, nee Weindel, at St. Paul Catholic Church, Highland, IL, who passed away on Friday, March 13, 2020.

He was also a member of Helvetia Sharpshooters Society, Highland, IL; former member of the E & R Church, Highland, IL; former Alderman - City of Highland 1958 - 1962; former Trustee - Helvetia Township 1970 - 2000.

Bernell was born and grew up in Highland, IL; attended Kaufman Grade School, north of Highland and graduated from Highland High School in 1951. He recently moved to Sorento, IL to be with his son. From 1953 to 1970 he operated Deuser Eggs, Highland, IL; the operation had 20,000 chickens that produced eggs. In 1970 he began working for Churchill Truck Lines, St. Louis, MO, making local deliveries, he retired in 1992. He briefly sold State Farm Insurance. He was a Trustee for the Helvetia Township for 23 years; Highland City Alderman from 1958 to 1962 (Silver Lake was built during his tenure). He

enjoyed bowling, having bowled for many years, and on Feb 6, 1962, he bowled a perfect game. He was an avid hunter of racoons, fox and coyotes. He also enjoyed fishing. He loved working with and helping his sons. He was always helping Gary on the farm. The past few years, he took good care of his wife during her illness.
