Burnell L. "Barney" Hartlieb, age 71 of Highland, IL, died Sunday, June 29, 2014, at Deceased's Residence in Highland, IL.

He was born on Monday, January 11, 1943, in Highland, IL, the son of Chester F. and Evelyn L. (nee Kesner) Hartlieb.

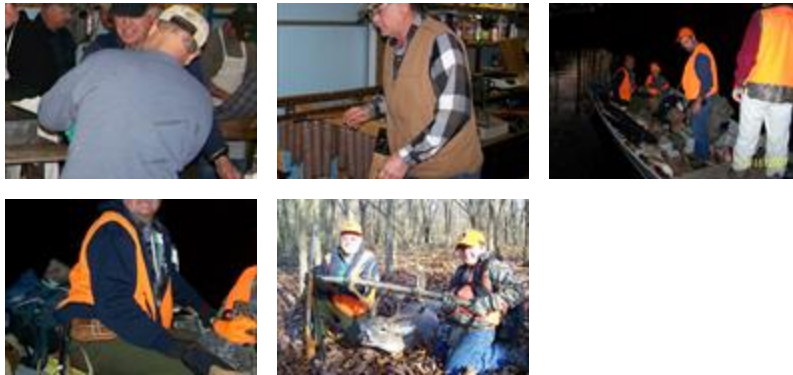
