Carl H. Hellmann, age 84 of Glen Carbon, IL, formerly of Hamel, IL, died Thursday, November 09, 2017, at Anderson Hospital in Maryville, IL.

He was born on Wednesday, December 21, 1932, in Hamel, IL, the son of Adolph and Lillian (nee Reising) Hellmann.

On Saturday, September 01, 1956, he married Marlene J. Hellmann nee Hafer, at the Presbyterian Church, Placentia, CA, who survives.

He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Hamel, IL; former member of the Meat Cutters Union, California; Meat Cutters Union Local 88, St. Louis, MO; Meat Cutters Union Local 534, Belleville, IL; Hamel Volunteer Fire Dept. (past Captain).

He was born and raised at Hamel Township; attended St. Paul Lutheran School, Hamel, IL. He served with the US Navy, duty in California and six months overseas during the Korean War.
