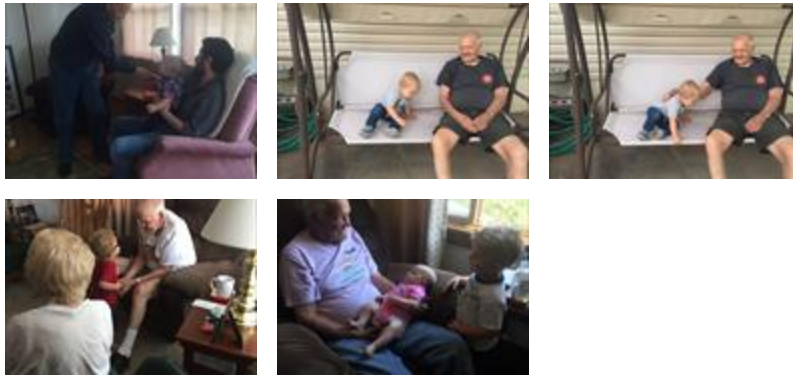
Interment will be at Keystone Cemetery in Saint Jacob, IL.
