Dale Burnett Porter, Jr., age 50, of Highland, IL., died Sunday, July 30, 2006, at his residence in Highland, IL.

He was born June 11, 1956, in Highland, IL., the son of Dale Burnett and Mary (nee Kantner) Porter.

On October 20, 1979, he married Carey Lynn Porter (nee Gilomen), who survives.
