



## Donnie E. Eddy

January 12, 1951 - December 3, 2014

Donnie Eugene Eddy, age 63 of Marine, IL, died Wednesday, December 3, 2014, at Saint Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

He was born on Friday, January 12, 1951, in Rector, AR, the son of David and Marlas (nee Jackson) Eddy.

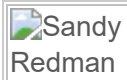
