



Dorothy P. Duffey

April 24, 1918 - April 2, 2007

Dorothy Pauline (Turner) Duffey, age 88, of Godfrey, IL., died Monday, April 2, 2007, at United Methodist Village in Godfrey, IL.

She was born April 24, 1918, in Ohlman, IL., the daughter of Paul and Iva (Schwarm) Turner.

On January 16, 1943, she married Raymond E. Duffey, who survives.

She was a member of Main Street United Methodist Church-Alton.

Dorothy graduated from Pana Township High School in 1936. She received a Masters Degree from SIUE in Guidance and Counseling with graduate work in music education at Bradley University and University of Illinois. She taught music in many area schools from 1938-1978, when she retired from Alton School District #11.

From 1969-1974 she helped organize the Alton Youth Symphony. From 1972-1978 she was conductress of the Allen Singers, associated with YWCA. She was a member of the Alton Symphony Orchestra Guild from 1978 to 1998 and was past president of the Greater Alton Concert Association and was responsible for the preparation of 77 formal concerts. In 1992 she received the Alton YWCA Woman of Distinction in Arts Award, and in 2000 She was honored with SIUE Kimmel Leadership Award.
