



## Erma M. Accornero

Erma Maria Accornero, age 94, of Pocahontas, IL., died Wednesday, April 21, 2010, at Breese Nursing Home in Breese, IL.

She was born December 3, 1915, in West Virginia, the daughter of Giovanni "John" and Malvina (nee Fracchia) Accornero.
