Flora H. "Flo" Wellington, age 91 of Hialeah, FL, died Tuesday, June 21, 2011, at Palm Springs Hospital in Hialeah, FL.

She was born on Tuesday, April 13, 1920, in St. Louis, MO, the Daughter of Dr. George G. and Grace (nee Everett) Herman.

She was a member of Who's Who of American Women-11th Edition; Professor Emeritus; Dept of Medical Library & Biomedical Communications; University of Miami School of Medicine; Dade County Library Assoc.; Florida Medical Library; Medical Library Assoc.; Southern Chapter-Medical Library Assoc.; National Daughters of the American Revolution.

Flora was born at St. Louis, MO; her father was a surgeon in the United States Navy. Growing up the family lived on naval bases on the East Coast, Philippines, Panama Canal and Guam. She married and divorced. She had lived in Miami since 1956, retired from the University of Miami School of Medicine, as a medical librarian in December 1984. She attained a B.S. from William & Mary College, and B.S. in Library Science from University of North Carolina. The year prior to her retirement she was the Acting Head of the Medical Library.
