Fremont G. Holzinger, age 81 of Highland, IL, died Saturday, May 22, 2021, at Saint Elizabeth's Hospital in O'Fallon, IL.

Fremont was born on Wednesday, October 11, 1939, in Highland, IL, to Albert and Frieda (nee Baumgartner) Holzinger.

On October 6, 1962 he married Rita Ottensmeier in Highland, IL.

He was a member of St. Paul Catholic Church, Highland, IL.

Fremont was born on the family farm. He lived in the area all his life which included Grantfork, Marine and Highland. He served in the United States Army from February 1960 - October 1965. He worked as a body repairman at Schmitt Chevrolet in Greenville, IL and then for Young Bros. Pontiac in Collinsville, IL. He then joined his brother in the ownership of Holzinger Real Estate Agency which had offices in Highland, Greenville, Litchfield, Staunton, Troy, Trenton and New Baden. Fremont was involved in the real estate industry for over 40 years, retiring in his late 70's, while continuing to own and manage rental properties. 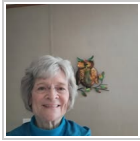

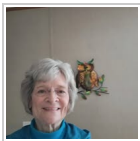
