



## Gerald L. Wall

Gerald Louis Wall, age 80, of Highland, IL., died Tuesday, March 6, 2007, at Saint Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

He was born March 22, 1926, in Greenville, IL., the son of Perry and Alice (Hochuli) Wall.

On December 2, 1944, he married Caroline M. Wall, nee Kehrli, who survives.

Mr. Wall was born at Greenville and grew up in the Donnellson and Greenville areas. At age 15 he moved to Highland.
