Gladys L. Rogier nee Lebeque, age 98, of Highland, IL., died Monday, November 23, 2009, at Anderson Hospital in Maryville, IL.

She was born April 19, 1911, in Highland, IL., the daughter of Zeph and Ethel (Malan) Lebeque.

On June 3, 1931, she married Max D. Rogier who passed away February 9, 1997.

Gladys was born in Sebastopol, southeast of Highland, where she grew up and attended country school and graduated from Highland High School in 1929. She was blessed with piano talent and showcased this at her graduation. She was the only one of her class to have a part in the program, playing "Shadows on the Water" at the Lory Theater. She married Max Rogier on June 3, 1931 and the two farmed for a number of years before moving to Highland in 1958. She worked in the office at Moulton Bartley Shoe Factory, then worked for Dr L.P. Rehberger's Office, and worked 20 years at St. Joseph Hospital as switch board operator, before retiring in 1976. She and Max traveled extensively, and went to Branson every fall. She did some volunteer work and was blessed with 11 grandchildren, 30 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandson.

She was a member of First Baptist Church-Highland, IL.

She was also a former member of Bethany Baptist Church; Women's Society of the Church; Pierian Reading Club; and Madison County Home Bureau.
