



## Glenn A. Noeltner

June 1, 1934 - August 23, 2014

Glenn A. Noeltner, age 80 of Saint Jacob, IL, died Saturday, August 23, 2014, at Anderson Hospital in Maryville, IL.

He was born on Friday, June 01, 1934, in Highland, IL, the son of John P. and Viola E. (nee May) Noeltner.

On Saturday, February 14, 1959, he married Jane P. Noeltner (nee Woll) who survives.
