Gloria L. Stuckwisch, age 93 of Highland, IL, died Wednesday, November 25, 2020, at Cedarhurst of Highland in Highland, IL.

She was born on June 20, 1927, in Highland, IL, the daughter of Edgar and Lulu (nee Tschannen) Schmidt.

On May 23, 1948, she married Kenneth Raymond Stuckwisch at E & R Church in Highland, IL. He passed away on October 06, 2008.

She was a member of Evangelical United Church of Christ. She was also a member of St. Joseph Hospital Auxiliary (Charter Member - 1968) Women's Guild (Honorary Member) Driver for Meals On Wheels .

Gloria was born at home, 519-12th St., Highland, IL. She was delivered by Dr. Merwin and a midwife. She was baptized also at home on her dad's birthday, November 24, 1927. She attended Highland Public School, graduating in 1945. She attended and graduated from Brown's Business School in St. Louis, MO. She was employed as secretary for AMVETS (American Veterans of World War II) in St. Louis. Then employed at C.J. Hug Truck Company and Imperial Clock Works in Highland. She became an insurance agent for M.F.A. (Missouri Farmers Association) with an office in her home, while being a full-time homemaker. Except for 1959-1966, when she and her family lived in

Tucson, Arizona, they lived their entire married life in Highland. Her outside-the-home interests consisted of volunteer services, as a charter member of the St. Joseph's Hospital Auxiliary, beginning in 1968, life-time member of the Evangelical United Church of Christ, honorary member of the Evangelical United Church of Christ Women's Guild, 18 years as a Sunday School Teacher, 20 years Highland Home Volunteer, Meals On Wheels Driver, Grant Prairie 4-H projects, her children's and grandchildren's church and school activities. She enjoyed compiling hospital auxiliary and family scrapbooks, preserving photo albums for her three children, five grandchildren, and her husband's talented woodwork projects. She also enjoyed crocheting and various crafts.
