Harold K. \"Sonny\" Cain, age 65, of Alhambra, IL., died Thursday, May 15, 2008, at his residence in Alhambra, IL.

He was born February 19, 1943, in New Harmony, IN., the son of Howard and Bonnie (Wilson) Cain.

Sonny was born in Indiana, and attended Crossville High School in IL and graduated from Richland High School in Olney, IL.
