



## Helen A. Glassmaker Haller

June 28, 1917 - February 20, 2009

Helen A. Glassmaker Haller (nee Trautner), age 91, of Highland, IL., died Friday, February 20, 2009, at Alhambra Care Center in Alhambra, IL.

She was born June 28, 1917, in Grantfork, IL., the daughter of Bernard and Hilda (nee Klaus) Trautner.

On February 7, 1937, she married Earl J. Glassmaker; he died March 17, 1974; later she married Edward Haller on April 17, 1982, he died May 15, 1999.

She was a member of Grantfork United Church of Christ, Grantfork, IL; Grantfork UCC Women's Guild; Highland Senior Citizens Club.

Mrs. Haller was born north of Grantfork, IL; she grew up on the farm; at age 14 the family moved into Grantfork; following her marriage, she and her husband farmed for 9 years northeast of Grantfork; they lived in St. Rose, IL, for 1 1/2 years and then moved to Highland. From 1953 to 1967 she helped her husband in the operation of their Honegger's Feed Store in Highland. She also had worked at Highland Supply Corp., Jakel Manufacturing and as a cook at Chastain's Nursing Home. She served on the Tour Committee for the Senior Citizens Club; enjoyed a big garden, a flower garden and loved making quilt blocks. She moved to Alhambra Care Center, July 3, 2007.
