



## Herman E. Sparks

March 30, 1922 - June 7, 2008

Herman E. Sparks, age 86, of Highland, IL., died Saturday, June 7, 2008, at Memorial Hospital in Belleville, IL.

He was born March 30, 1922, in Onley, IL., the son of George and Hazel (Vaughn) Sparks Gregory.

On May 11, 1940, he married Janet N. Sparks nee Carson , who passed away October 2, 1987.

Mr. Sparks served with the US Army Infantry from July 25, 1944 until Dec. 20, 1945, with duty in Central Europe, the Rhineland, and Ardennes; was a prisoner of war in Germany for three months. Lived in Salem, IL, after marriage. He and his wife travelled through out the US as he followed the boilermaker welding trade. They settled in Highland, IL, March, of 1963. He retired in 1973. He built a mirrored ball at Lindendale Park Ball Room and made stainless steel belt buckles. He enjoyed traveling especially going on Bus Tours.
