Howard W. Robertson, age 75, of Highland, IL., died Monday, April 12, 2010, at Faith Care Center in Highland, IL.

He was born August 26, 1934, in Springfield, MO., the son of Howard and Molene (nee Nelson) Robertson.

On June 4, 1955, he married Norma J. (nee Massman) Robertson , who survives.

Mr. Robertson was born at Springfield, MO, at an early age his family moved to Mitchell, IL. He graduated from Granite City High School in 1952. He received a full football scholarship to the University of Missouri where he played football for four years and graduated with a BS in Agriculture. He was also a member of ROTC and entered the US Army as a Second Lt. He served with the First Artillery Division (Big Red One). He and his wife moved to Highland, IL in 1959 where he opened the Howard Robertson State Farm Agency, which is still operating in Highland today. In college, Howard was a member of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity; he is a member of the University of Missouri Alumni Association and many, many organizations in Highland. For years, he was a member of the football chain gang at every Highland football game. Mr. & Mrs. Robertson travelled extensively - they have been to every continent; enjoyed motorhome travel; have a winter home in Gulf Shores, AL,

and have spent winter time in Sarasota, FL since 1981.
