Irma L. Liebler, beloved mother and friend, was born in Highland, IL and lived in the area for all of her 91 years. Following a brief illness, Irma died on Wednesday, October 6, 2010 at Faith Countryside Homes in Highland.

The daughter of George A. and Mary M. Clementz (nee Mueller), she was born on December 10, 1918, graduated from Highland High School at age 16, worked in banking and a medical office, and then was married to Richard A. Liebler from 1940 to 1969.

They lived with their three children on a farm south of Highland where she enjoyed farm life, as well as a social life in Highland playing piano with a dance band, bowling, and playing cards. Ballroom dancing was a passion for many years.

She began a government career in 1969 at Scott Air Force Base, and spent 23 happy years there.

Irma traveled to visit the homes of her children, and she joined them on trips to Switzerland and other European countries, Hawaii, Mexico, and the beaches of South Carolina.
