James E. Watson, age 83 of Highland, IL, peacefully passed away on Wednesday, September 4, 2024 at his home surrounded by his loving family

He loved music and introduced his children to the sounds of Elvis and Tina Turner. He also enjoyed traveling with his family. Having spent so much time in the air as a pilot, he especially loved a road trip or a cruise as a welcome change of pace. Alaska and Colorado were his favorite places to visit with his family.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his siblings Joyce Watson Gregson, Jerry L. Watson and Marie Watson Lovelace.
