Joan M. Sackett, age 92 of Highland, IL, died Monday, April 22, 2024, at HSHS St. Joseph's Hospital in Highland, IL.

She was born on Monday, May 11, 1931, in Highland, IL, the daughter of Clarence and Ida (nee Sues) Oberbeck.

On Sunday, June 18, 1950, she married Billy George Sackett at E & R Church, by Rev. Fred C. Aldrich, who passed away on Tuesday, June 19, 2007.

She enjoyed volunteering at church, with the nursery and ushering; was in charge of Women's Guild Honor Guard; volunteered at blood bank at the V.F.W. for years and Meals on Wheels for years.
