Joseph Earl Campbell, age 81 of Highland, IL, died Friday, July 18, 2014, at Highland Health Care Center in Highland, IL.

He was born February 8, 1933, in Perry, MO, the son of Spencer R. and Vishie Siotha (nee Moore) Campbell.
