



## Kenneth W. Hanselman

February 21, 1930 - January 24, 2014

Kenneth W. Hanselman, age 83 of Highland, IL, died Friday, January 24, 2014, at IL Veteran Home, Quincy, IL.

He was born on Friday, February 21, 1930, in Highland, IL, the son of Otto L. and Alma (nee Gilomen) Hanselman.

On Saturday, November 15, 1958, he married Anne L. Hanselman (nee Mease) who passed away on Thursday, September 16, 1999.

He was a member of Evangelical United Church of Christ, Highland, IL; V.F.W. Post 5694, Highland, IL; former member of Meatcutter's Local 534 - Belleville, IL.
