Kevin Ray Neudecker, age 66 of Highland, IL, died Sunday, February 16, 2025, at Saint Louis University Hospital in Saint Louis, MO.

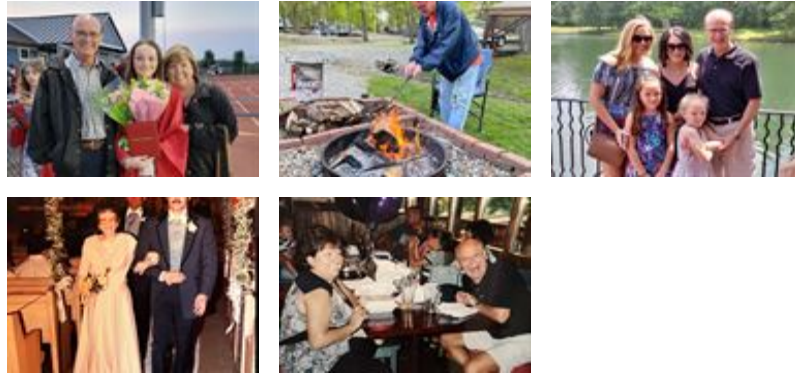
