Lawrence A. "Larry" Haislar, age 83, of Pierron, IL., died Friday, June 26, 2009, at Highland Health Care Center in Highland, IL.

He was born August 3, 1925, in St. Rose, IL., the son of Frederick and Hildegarde (Geiger) Haislar.

Worked at Basler Electric in 1964, Ford Motor Company in St. Louis 1966 to 1974, then Horn Trucking in Highland. At age 73, in 1997 he received his GED. He was very active in the VFW, liked to garden, read, shoot pool, and spend time with his grandkids.
