



## Lorena B. Senn

May 4, 1910 - June 22, 2008

Lorena B. (nee Hug) Senn, age 98, of Cedarburg, WI., died Sunday, June 22, 2008, at Luther Manor in Milwaukee, WI.

She was born May 4, 1910, in Highland, IL., the daughter of Julius and Bertha (nee Lang) Hug.

On October 10, 1928, she married Roland W. Senn, who passed away September 24, 1967.

She was a member of Evangelical United Church of Christ; Royal Neighbors of America, Imerpial Camp #1957 (a former Oracle of the Camp & held numerous other offices); Order of Eastern Star, Chapter #524; Highland Historical Society; St. Joseph Hospital S.H.I.P. (Senior Health Insurance Program); Faith Countryside Homes Aux. (Friends of Faith); Hitz Memorial Nursing Home Aux.; Weinheimer Senior Citizens (Chaplain for several years); Women's Guild of the Church.

Lorena B. Senn was born on May 4, 1910, St. Rose Township, Clinton County, (rural route Highland) IL.

At the age of six, the family moved into Highland, where she has spent her entire life. Mrs. Senn attended the Highland Schools and graduated from Highland High School in June of 1927. After high school, she became a secretary at the Hug Company, a truck assembling firm of Highland. She then spent several years at home raising her son and became employed at Highland Schools when he entered kindergarten. She served as Educational Secretary for the Highland Community Unit School District of Highland, Pierron, Grantfork, Alhambra and New Douglas, until retiring in 1973. For all of her life, the school has continued to hold a prominent place in her life and heart. In 1962 she was certified as an Educational Secretary by the National Assoc. of Educational Secretaries.

Her church held a high place in her life - She was baptised, confirmed and married in the Evangelical United Church of Christ. In her younger years, she was a Church School teacher for almost twenty years. In later years, she served on the church consistory and

as President of the church. She was privileged to serve in wider aspects of the church by having been Moderator of the Illinois South Conference of the United Church of Christ and twice as a delegate to the U.C.C. Synod meetings.

She was a Life Member of the Illinois Association of Educational Office Personnel, having served a term as President. She was also a retired Life Member of the National Assoc. of Educational Office Personnel, having participated in several summer seminars.
