Lorraine Meta (Schoeck) Beeler Suess, age 92, of Highland, IL., died Thursday, September 4, 2008, at St. Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

She made deaded Christmas tree ornaments as a avocation and made old fashion cookies at Christmas. She was also known for her special Cole Slaw she made for family occasions.

She was a member of UCC of St. Jacob. She was also a member of Women's Guild of St. Jacob UCC.
