



## Louise Langenberg

May 20, 1910 - May 2, 2008

Louise (Logue) Langenberg, age 97, of Highland, IL., died Friday, May 2, 2008, at Faith Care Center in Highland, IL.

She was born May 20, 1910, in Highland, IL., the daughter of Michael and Louisa (Buchter) Logue.

On February 8, 1945, she married Elmer L. Langenberg, who passed away February 28, 1976.

Mrs. Langenberg was born and raised in Highland, IL. She worked at the Moulton-Bartley Shoe Factory in the office for 13 1/2 years prior to her marriage.
