Played cards on many weekends. Shared many fun times and a few bad times.

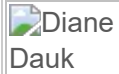
Marlene was a very good cook, my family always hoped she had made Lasagna

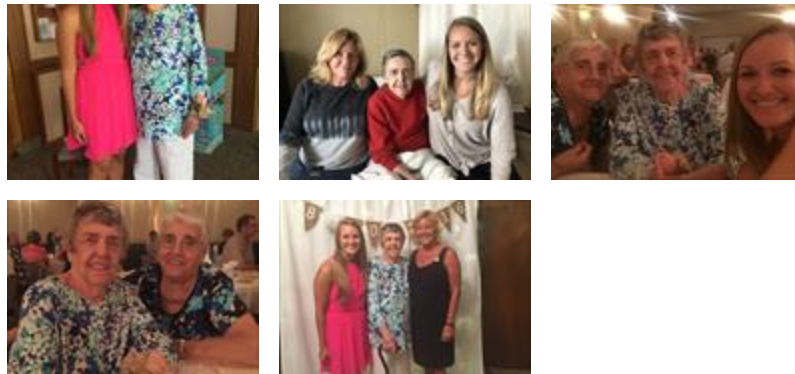
