Melbern L. "Mel" Carrillon, age 86 of Highland, IL, died Tuesday, August 26, 2014, at his residence in Highland, IL.

He was born on Tuesday, August 21, 1928, in Lebanon, IL, the son of Henry F. and Josephine L. (nee Voges) Carrillon.

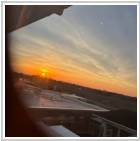
