Michael Marshall Davis, 61, of Highland, Illinois, died on May 10, 2011 at Barnes Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

Mike was born July 27, 1949 to Elma Lou (nee Marshall) and Robert W. Davis in Macomb, Illinois, who preceded him in death. He attended Western Illinois University Laboratory School in Macomb, Illinois where he graduated from high school in 1967. He attended Canton Community College in Canton, IL prior to enlisting in the U.S. Air Force. Mike served his country during the Viet Nam War as a Staff Sergeant, spending time in Saigon, Viet Nam and Thailand. He was honorably discharged from the military in 1976.

After completing military service he was employed with the U.S. Dept. of Defense as a Computer Specialist at Scott Air Force Base, Belleville, IL and residing in Highland, IL. After retiring in 2000 he opened American Travel Express airport transportation service, which he enjoyed operating until the time of death.

He was previously married to Susan Davis (nee Davis) of Brighton, IL, remaining lifetime friends with her and her family. Mike was an Eagle Boy Scout who enjoyed hunting, fishing, boating, antiquing, collecting, and spending time with his beloved Irish Setter dog, Casey.
