



## Mildred E. Ginther

July 4, 1910 - February 18, 2009

Mildred E. Ginther, nee Saxe age 98, of Highland, IL., died Wednesday, February 18, 2009, at Faith Care Center/Faith Countryside Hms in Highland, IL.

She was born July 4, 1910, in Albion, IL., the daughter of William and Bessie (Cox) Saxe.

On December 20, 1929, she married Delmar R. Ginther, who passed away September 16, 1973.

Born in Edwards County, IL; lived in Albion, IL from age 8 to 19; got married and moved to Hammond, Indiana; moved to Edwardsville, IL in 1943, lived there until moving to California for one year and then moving to Highland, IL in 1953 and living there ever since. Mrs. Ginther and her late husband formerly operated and managed the Highland Country Club for some three years; she worked in the office of Dr. Edward L. Hediger (later known as Highland Physicians) for 21 years as a secretary from 1957 to her retirement in 1978. Mrs. Ginther was very active in church and community affairs. She enjoyed playing cards, and was well known for her generosity in helping people. In her retirement she was a "Sitter" at Highland Home for several years.
