Muriel Y. Brockmeier, age 84 of Highland, IL, died Thursday, October 24, 2019, at Saint Mary Health Center in Saint Louis, MO.

She was born on Wednesday, July 31, 1935, in Highland, IL, the daughter of Henry and Ida (nee Matzinger) Schrupf.

On Saturday, May 04, 1963, she married Earl E. Brockmeier at E & R Church-Grantfork, IL, who survives.
