Nancy L. Kaufman, age 77 of Plymouth, WI, died Wednesday, August 21, 2019, at San Gabriel Memory Care in Highland, IL.

She was born on December 20, 1941, in Great Bend, KS, the daughter of Steve and Dorothy (nee Rupp) Brooks.
