



## Orville J. Landmann

January 12, 1929 - May 18, 2020

Orville J. Landmann, age 91 of Highland, IL, died Monday, May 18, 2020, at Highland Health Care Center in Highland, IL.

He was born on Saturday, January 12, 1929, in Pocahontas, IL, the son of Henry and Ida (nee Frisse) Landmann.

On Tuesday, June 02, 1953, he married Olivia V. Landmann nee Ratermann at St. Dominic's Catholic Church, Breese, IL, who passed away on Saturday, April 25, 2020.

He was a member of Saint Paul Catholic Church, Highland, IL; Knights of Columbus, Council 1580, Highland, IL; Knights of Columbus, Fourth Degree Assembly #0231, Highland, IL; VFW Post 5694, Highland, IL (Past Commander).

He was born and raised in rural Pocahontas on the family farm and graduated from St. Paul High School in 1947. He grew up working on the family farm, later he worked for his brother-in-law at the saw mill and then he served in the US Army, overseas during the Korean War from 3/1951 to 3/1953. After returning home he married Olivia and they moved to Highland. He worked 37 years at Community Lumber Co, Highland and later worked 20 years at Rural King, Highland and retired at the age of 82 years old. He was very active in

many capacities with the Knights of Columbus, to highlight a few: Chairman of the Hall Building Committee; Council Treasurer for 37 years; ran Bingo since its inception in 1977; President of the Columbus Club; he received the Illinois Knights of Columbus "Hall of Fame". Many of the hours he spent there, his wife was by his side. He received a Paul Harris Fellow from the Highland Rotary Club and was a Past Commander of the VFW Post 5694, Highland, IL. He enjoyed a small garden, playing cards and helping his children with their home projects.
