Priscilla Mae Plocher, age 79 of Highland, IL, died Tuesday, November 2, 2021, at Saint Joseph's Hospital in Highland, IL.

She was born on Wednesday, July 29, 1942, in Highland, IL, the daughter of Leroy and Virginia (nee Keller) Buehler.
