Robert L. Zobrist, age 88 of Highland, IL, died Saturday, March 08, 2014, at Deceased's Residence in Highland, IL.

He then worked for Miss Elaine Garment Co., O'Fallon, IL until 1988. He was known in several counties for working on sewing machines. He worked on sewing machines from his house for over 50 years. He volunteer for Meals On Wheels, the Highland Food Pantry and drove people to hospitals and doctor appointments. He truly loved riding motorcycles; he and his wife travelled all over the United States.
