Robert L. Sueverkruebbe, age 80 of Highland, IL, died Wednesday, May 04, 2011, at Saint Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

He was born April 30, 1931, in Alvord, IA, the son of Herman and Ella (nee Mundt) Sueverkruebbe.

On November 24, 1962, he married Juanita June Sueverkruebbe (nee Hicks) who survives in Highland, IL.
