Stephan M. Lancey, age 55 of Highland, IL, died Friday, September 25, 2015, at his residence in Highland, IL.

He was born October 29, 1959, in East Saint Louis, IL, the son of Terry M. and Virginia L. (nee Chappell) Lancey.

He was a former member of Breese Knights of Columbus .

Mr. Lancey was born at East Saint Louis, IL. He & his family moved to Highland, IL in 1968. Stephan graduated from Highland High in 1977.
