Su-Hwei Chang, age 96 of Highland, IL, died Friday, October 24, 2014, at Saint Joseph Hospital in Highland, IL.

She was born on Saturday, March 16, 1918.

Su-Hwei was born in China; educated in China at Kaifend Girls Teachers Academy College earning a college degree (unusual for a Chinese lady in 1940).
